

Schedule for Plant Hosts/Docents at the Albuquerque Botanic Garden Show

The Cactus & Succulent Society of NM must have a minimum of two people hosting the showroom at all times. If we're lucky enough to fill all the time slots and there are still people who want to host, we can have more!

When you signup via email (RPeters52@gmail.com), please provide an emergency phone number and emergency contact name. Why?? We are required to provide a list of names of people working each day of the show, along with an emergency phone number and contact name. Because this is city property, it is probably a city requirement for workers on site in the event of an emergency. This information will be provided to the Botanic Garden Manager; it will not be published anywhere.

Rules set out in agreement:

All "hosts" and "workers" **MUST** wear their CSSNM name tags at all times while inside the fee area of the Garden.

Only CSSNM volunteers will receive free admission while they work and during set up/take down. Family, friends, and general non-working members of CSSNM must pay admission. Anyone can come and go to/from classroom during presentations since that is not a fee area. Committee members will monitor admission to the botanic garden of CSSNM members to ensure that only members working the days of the show are allowed entry free of charge when they work. (This is not an issue for those of us who are members of the BioPark.)

All volunteer parking will be in the main public lots.

Setup Schedule--Thursday, 31 August: We'll begin setting up the showroom at 11:00 a.m. . We'll begin receiving Show Plants at 1:00 p.m. All plants should be delivered by 5:00 p.m. when the Botanic Garden closes.

Take-Down Schedule--Monday, 4 September: We will take down the exhibit at closing time for the Gardens. **Please arrive by 6:00 p.m. to pick up your Show Plants.**

Hosts: Those volunteering for the 9:00 a.m. shifts should arrive a few minutes early to have time to stash their stuff and get acquainted with the facility. **Be sure to wear your CSSNM name badges.**
